Marc A. Riedl, MD, MS, is a professor of medicine, the HAE Community Endowed Chair, and the Clinical Director of the US HAEA Angioedema Center at the University of California, San Diego (UCSD). He also serves as the Clinical Service Chief for the Division of Allergy & Immunology at UCSD. Dr Riedl received his medical degree from the University of Chicago - Pritzker School of Medicine in Chicago, IL. He then completed his residency in internal medicine at Barnes-Jewish Hospital of Washington University in St. Louis, MO and his fellowship in clinical immunology and allergy at UCLA School of Medicine - Center for the Health Sciences in Los Angeles, CA. He also received a Master of Science degree in Clinical Research at the David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA. Dr Riedl is board certified in allergy-immunology and clinical pharmacology.

Dr Riedl directs an active clinical research program at UCSD that is focused on angioedema and immunodeficiency conditions and lectures frequently at national and international medical conferences. He has published over 160 peer-reviewed manuscripts, including work in *The New England Journal of Medicine*, *JAMA*, and *The Lancet*. He serves on numerous scientific committees and expert panels for the FDA and NIH. Dr Riedl is a member of the editorial boards of *JACI: In Practice and Allergy and Asthma Proceedings*. He also serves on the US HAEA Medical Advisory Board, the Immune Deficiency Foundation Physician Advisory Committee, and the Board of Directors for the Western Society of Allergy, Asthma, and Immunology.

He is a clinical professor of internal medicine at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical School and teaches at Parkland Memorial Hospital. Dr Lumry received his medical degree from the University of Texas Medical Branch School of Medicine in Galveston, TX. He then completed an internship and his residency in internal medicine at the Barnes-Jewish Hospital at Washington University in St. Louis, MO and his clinical and research fellowship in allergy and immunology at Scripps Clinic and Research Institute in La Jolla, CA. Dr Lumry is board certified in allergy & immunology and internal medicine.

Dr Lumry has conducted over 500 clinical trials as the Medical Director of AARA Research Center and speaks and consults locally, nationally, and internationally about asthma, allergic and immune deficiency diseases, and hereditary angioedema.

Dr Lumry is a Fellow of the American College of Allergy, Asthma and Immunology, American Academy of Allergy, Asthma and Immunology, and the American College of Physicians. He has also served as the Past-President of the Texas Allergy, Asthma and Immunology Society and the American Lung Association (Dallas area) and as a Founding Director of the DFW Metroplex Allergy Society and the Asthma and Allergy Foundation of America (Texas).
